### A Variety of Activities

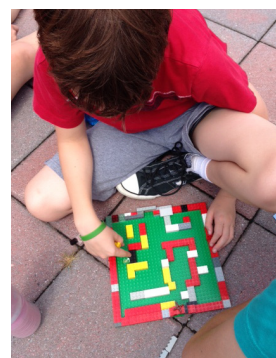
Campers will enjoy many fun activities in addition to swimming, including arts and crafts, yoga/athletics, theater and cooking.
